Swiss Cheese Pie

18 slices bacon, cooked and crumbled
4 eggs
2 cups heavy cream
3/4 tsp salt
1/8 tsp ground nutmeg
1/8 tsp sugar
1/16 tsp cayenne
1/8 tsp pepper
1 tbs butter, softened
1/4 lb. Swiss cheese, grated
9" pie shell, thawed

Heat oven to 425°. In a bowl, beat eggs with cream, salt, nutmeg, sugar, cayenne and pepper. Rub pie shell with softened butter. Sprinkle crumbled bacon and cheese in shell. Pour cream mixture over all. Bake 15 minutes. Reduce oven temperature to 300°. Bake 40 more minutes.

RVer's Know How for Gray and Black Water Holding Tanks

We have been approached on a couple occasions recently regarding the gray and black water holding tanks in an RV. There was an article published recently in *Highways Magazine*, which is published by the Good Sam Club. The article gives some useful tips on maintaining the holding tanks. Below are their recommendations for the black water tank:

- Use a good holding-tank treatment to break down waste and toilet tissue.
- Use toilet paper designed for

RV waste systems or for residential septic systems.

- Keep the black-tank dump valve **closed** when hooked up. When the tank gets from two-thirds to three-quarters full, empty it. This will prevent solids from building up in the bottom of your tank.
- Completely flush and rinse the black tank every time you return from a trip.

As the gray water tank does not require as much maintenance as the black water tank, their only recom-

mendation on it is to use a commercial tank cleaning product, once a month during full time usage. This will eat up deposits in the P-traps and clean up any build up in the pipe that may cause odors.
