One Dish Chicken & Stuffing Bake

4 cups stuffing
1-1/4 cups water
4 tbsp. butter
6 skinless, boneless chicken breast halves
Paprika
1 can Cream of Chicken Soup
1/3 cup milk
1 tbsp. chopped fresh parsley or
1 tsp. dried parsley flakes

Prepare stuffing using water and butter, according to package directions.

Spoon stuffing across center of 13 x 9 x2 shallow baking dish. Place chicken on each side of stuffing. Sprinkle chicken with paprika.

Stir soup, milk and parsley in bowl. Pour over chicken. Cover.

Bake at 400° for 30 min. or until chicken is cooked through.

Top 7 Motor Home Owner Maintenance Mishaps

A recent article was published in the Family Motor Coach Association's publication with regard to Motor home maintenance. In the article written by Mark Polk, the simplest of maintenance items can be overlooked by owners. Following is his list of items to remember to avoid costly repair bills.

1. Checking and adding air when the tires are hot.
2. Check the water level in batteries, periodically.
3. Rinse and flush the black water holding tank after you

empty it.

4. Perform pre-departure checks.
5. Periodically inspect your motor home for water damage.
6. Perform routine safety checks.
7. Maintain the RV water system.

Of course this article was geared toward Motor home owners, however, most of these also apply to Fifth Wheel and Travel Trailers owners too.
